Identity Cards by a Different Name

Most countries issue a National ID Card, but not all. For example, in Mexico the ID Card used at banks and in the legal system carries a different name, the "ELECTORAL" card. Other countries such as Zambia have the "National Registration Card" these types of cards are often issued based off a number given to citizens at birth or upon achieving residency.
